This is my very first video-clip ever which I upload to Youtube. It shows a 45s clip taken from the helmsman's position of Broremann. The camera was set in VGA-mode which consumed about 1.4MB/second or 63MB for that 45s clip - it took me 15 minutes to upload it. The video was a bit reduced in quality when presented from the YouTube. One thing to notice is the wind noise, even in just F3. I will experiment with a (woolen) wind noise damper on the built-in microphone.
